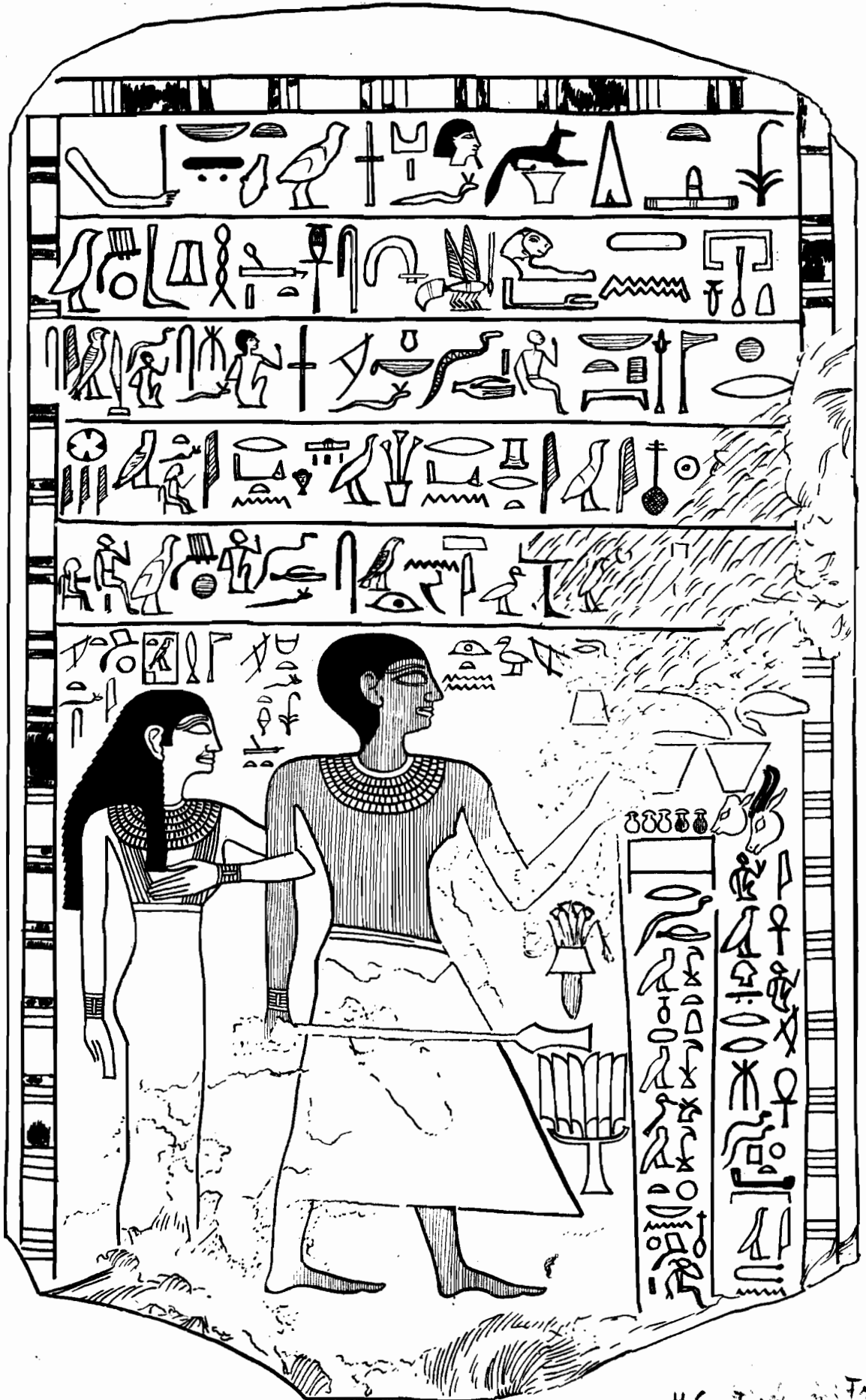

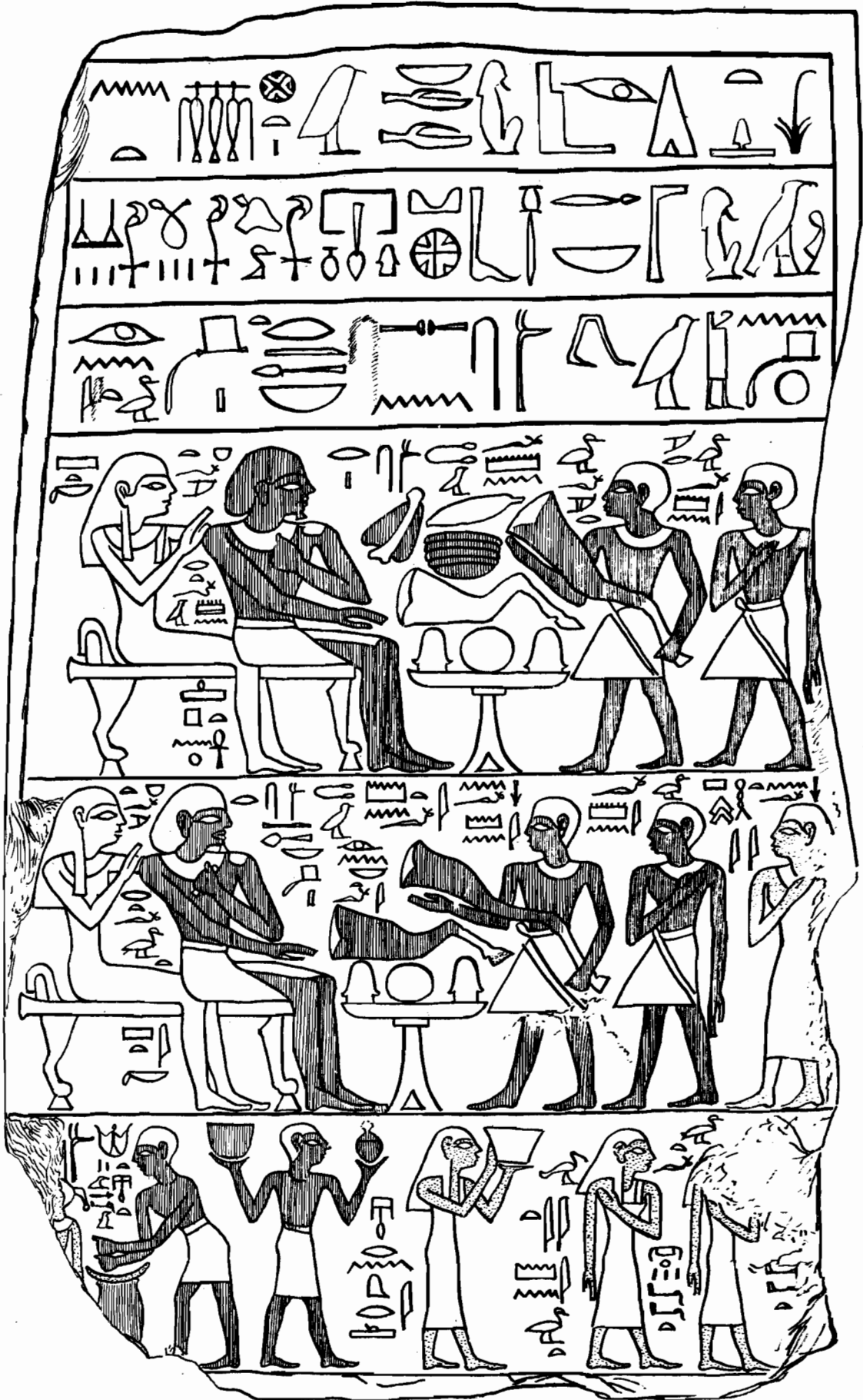

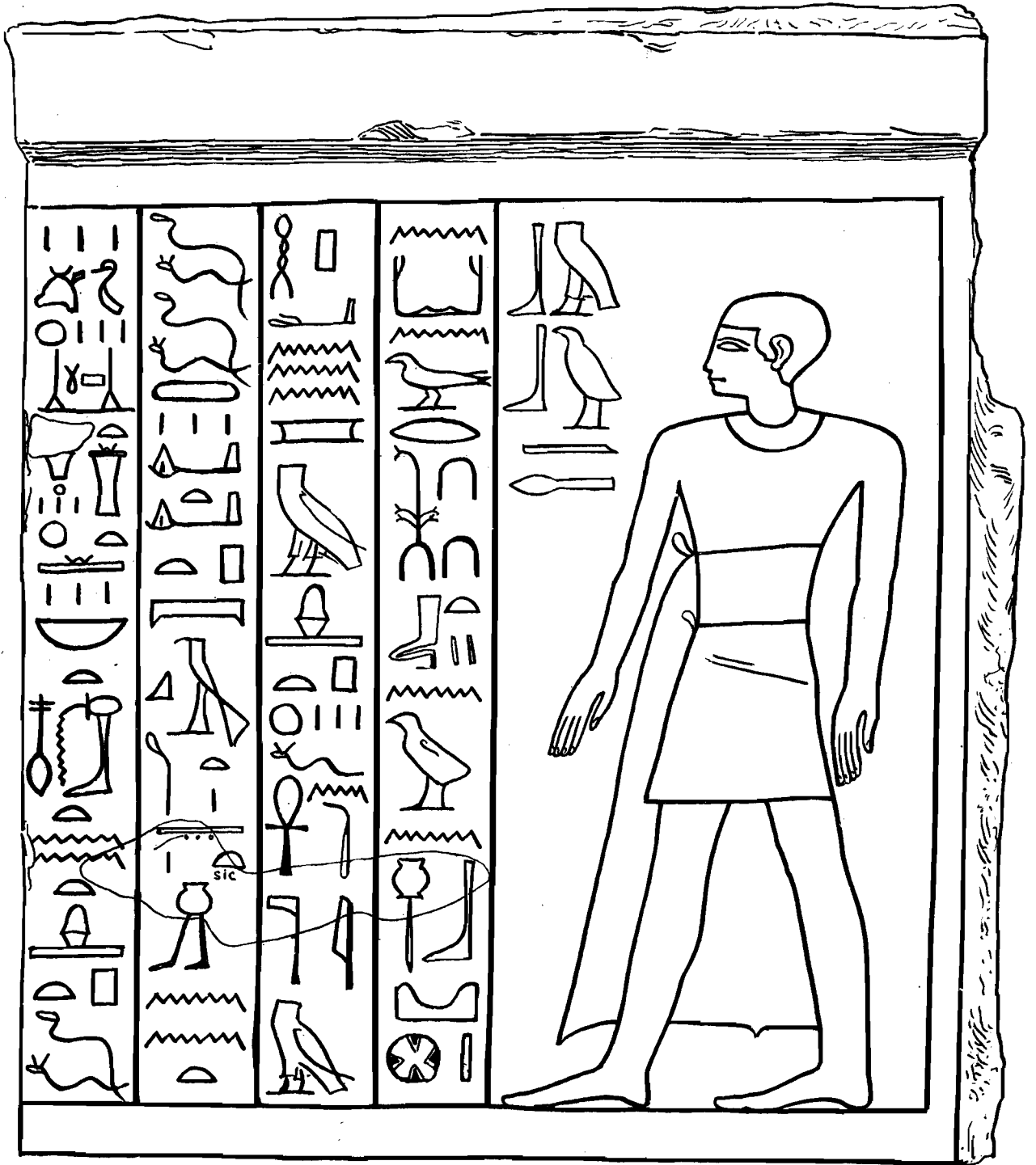
STELE OF SENUSERT SON OF SAT-ASHTEK.

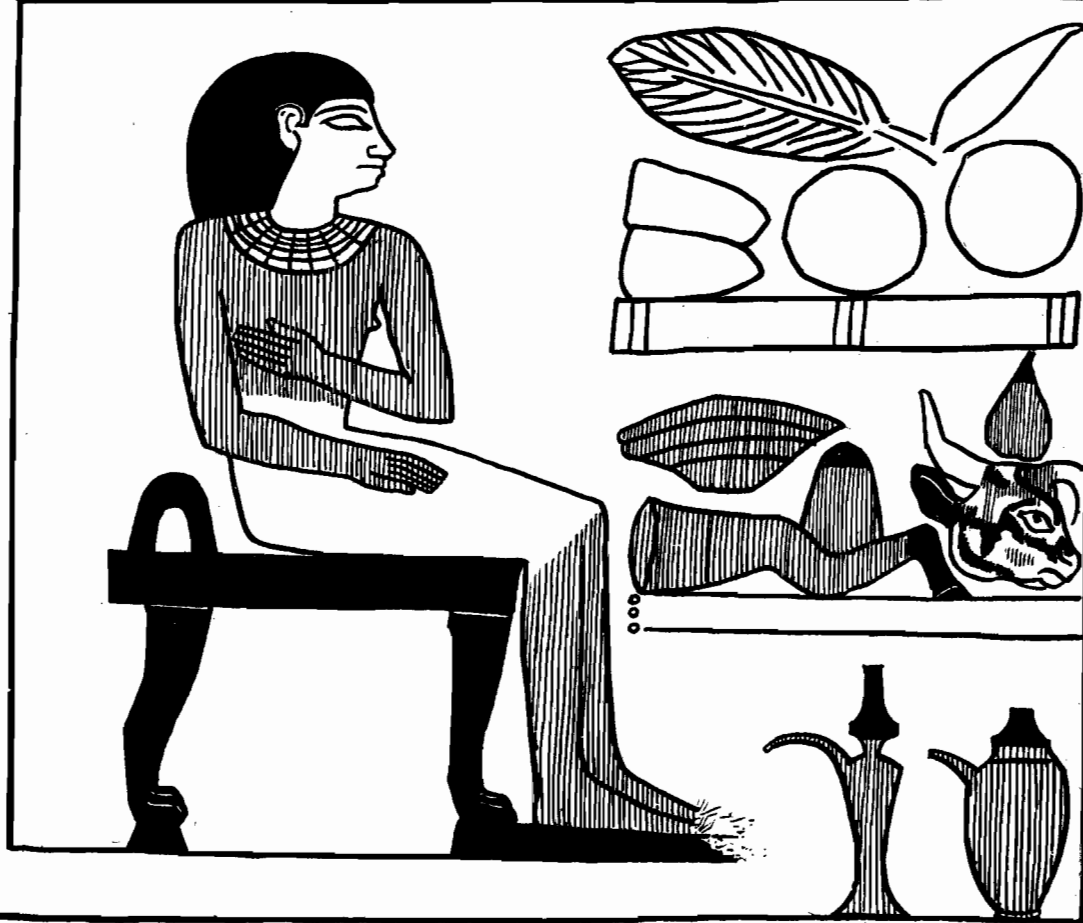

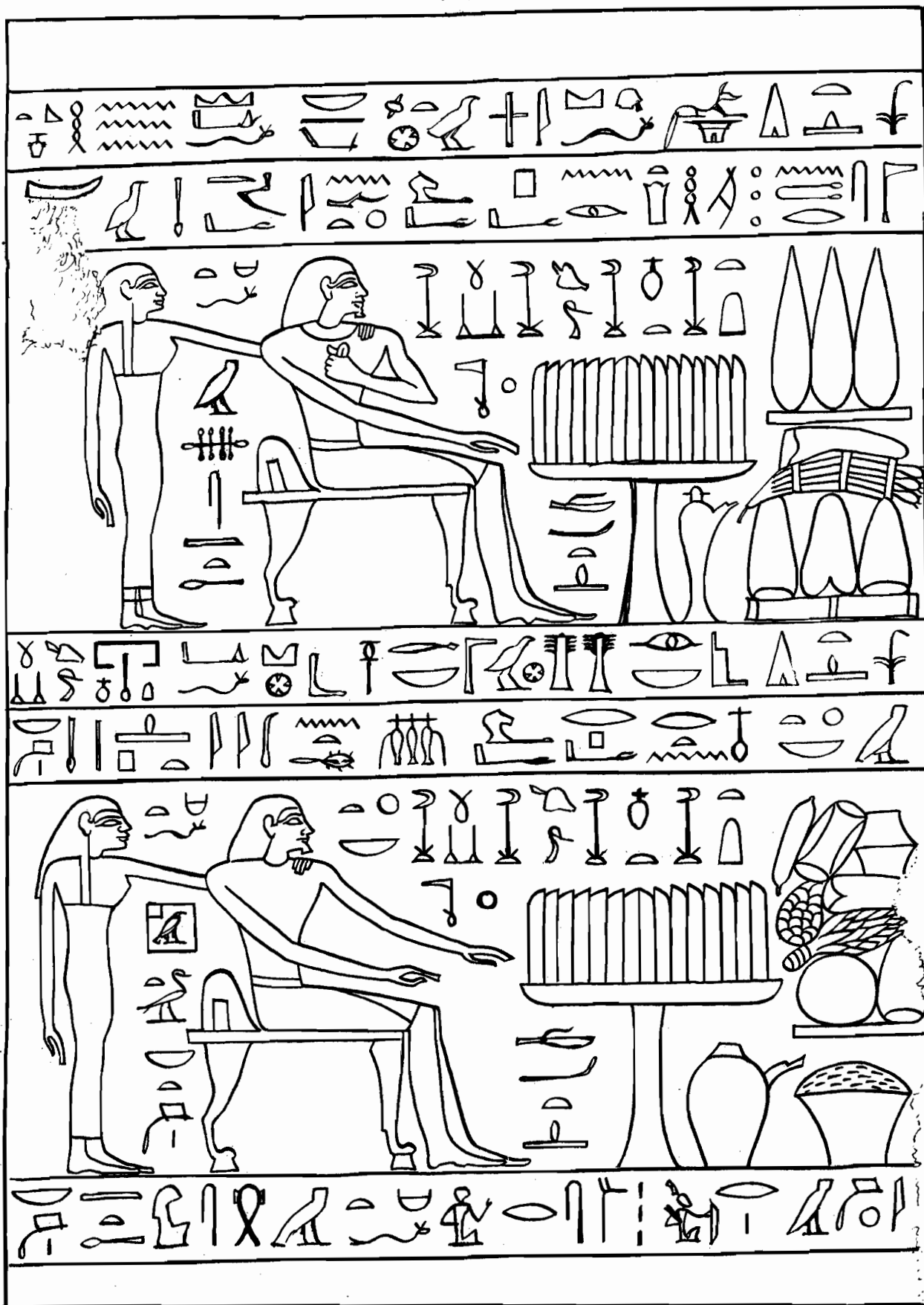

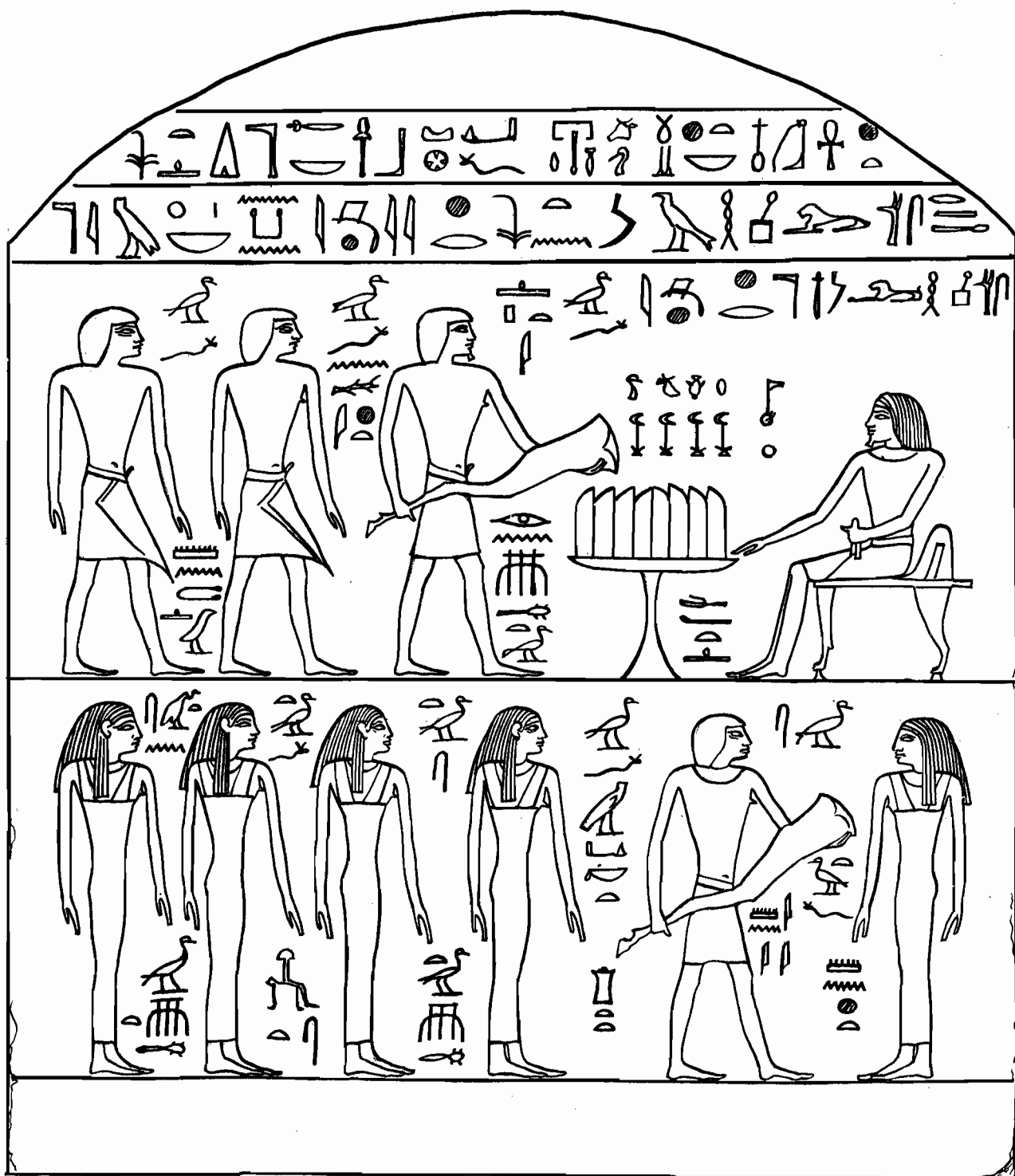
STELE OF NEKHTÄ AND KHENTIKHATI-ḤETEP.

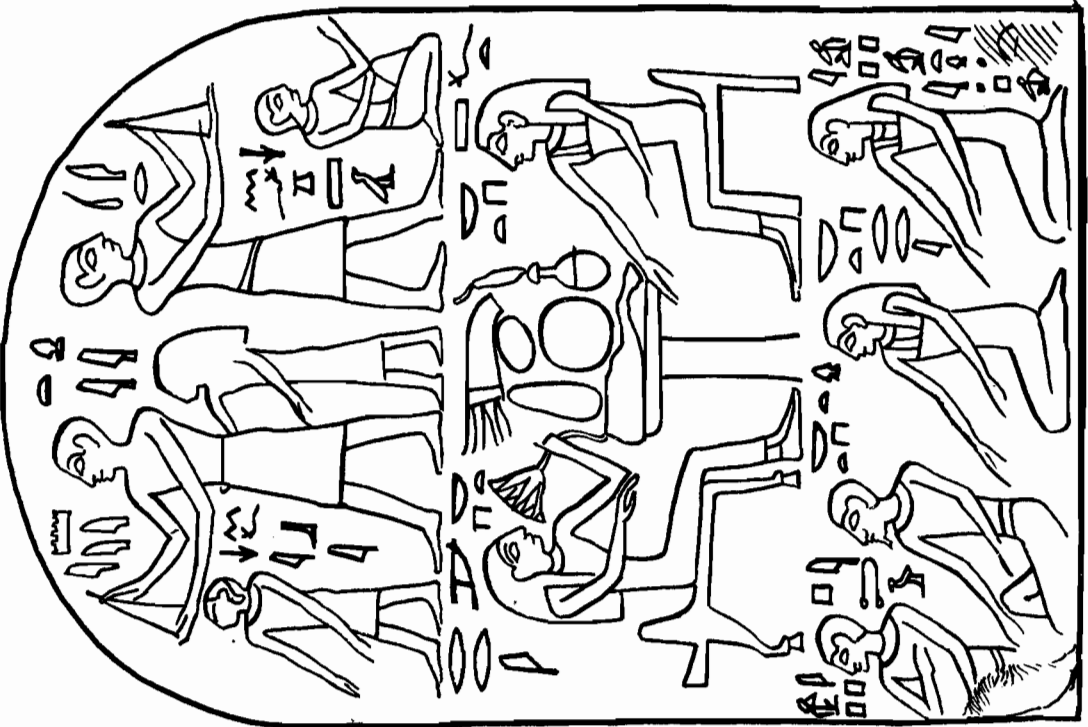

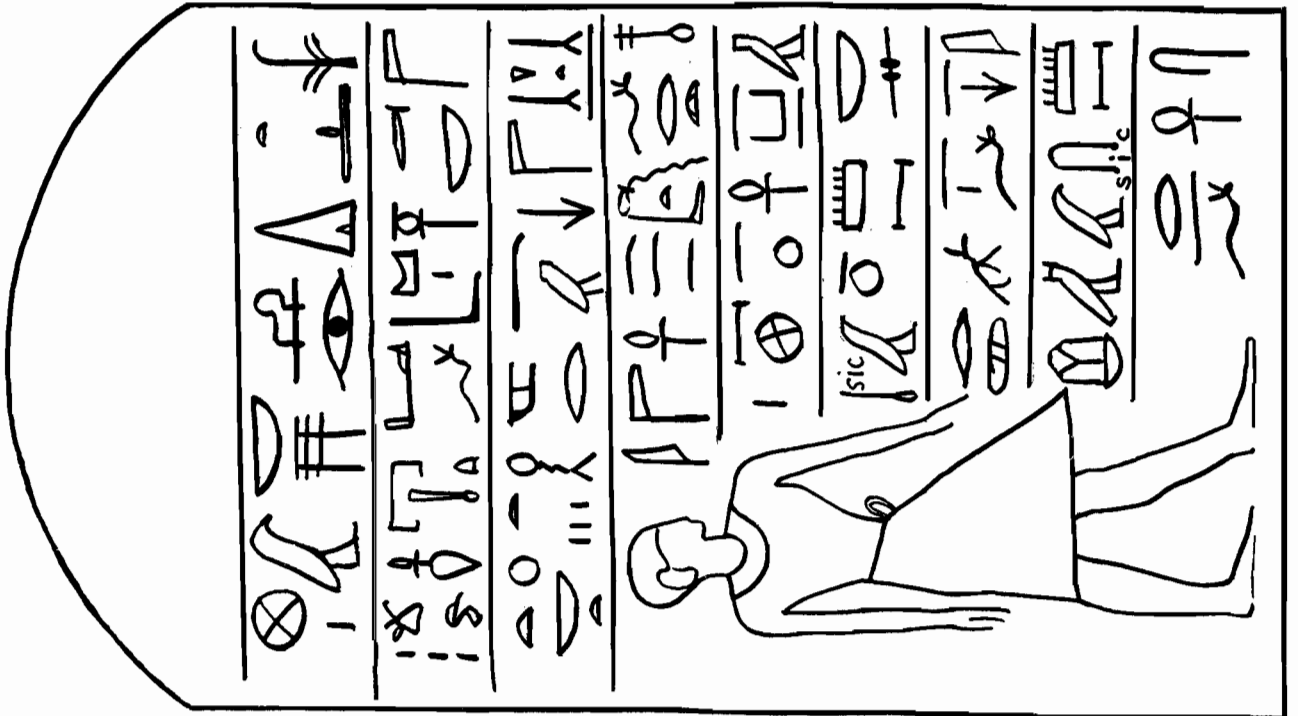

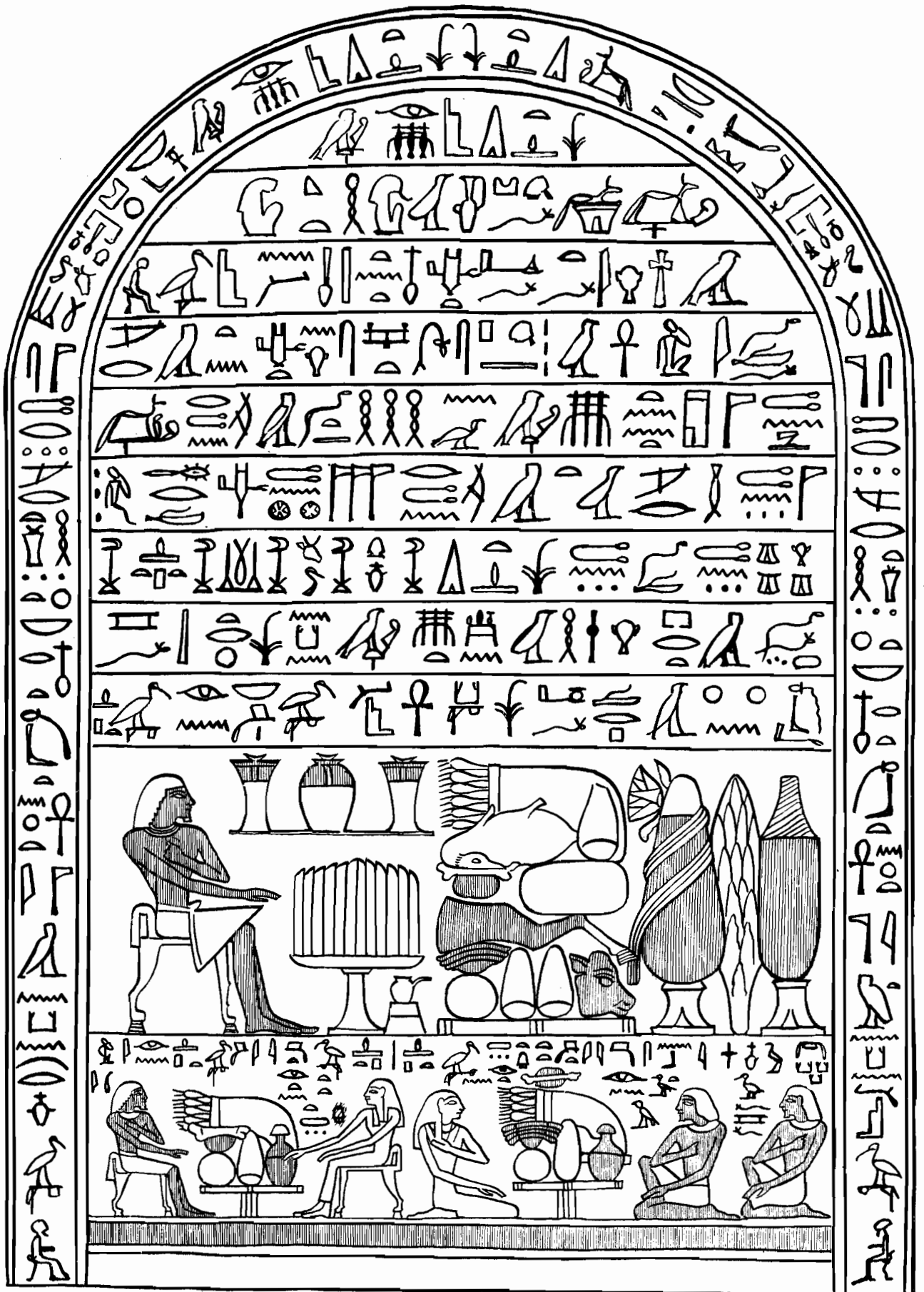
